Current ECAHO Blue Book Rules for Conduct of Shows (RCS)

Horses 12 months old and older cannot compete unless they have a veterinary certificate to verify that they do not have overbite/underbite. Geldings do not need a veterinary Hereditary Disorder certificate to compete.

Anybody submitting an incorrect declaration not corresponding to the true condition of the horse will receive a fine of 500€ (~A\$800). The original of the declaration of any such horse in violation will be kept by the DC.
